How to say the following sentences in Chinese? (The answer is in our live stream lesson based on this material.)

Pattern:

1. Verb + 不完 bù wán indicate you can't finish doing something
2. 没 méi + verb + 完 wán indicate you didn't finish doing something

- 1.I can't finish this cake. (say it with "eat")
- 2.I didn't finish that cake. (say it with "eat")
- 3.I can't finish this drink. (say it with "drink")
- 4.I didn't finish that drink. (say it with "drink")
- 5.I can't finish this book. (say it with "read")
- 6.I didn't finish that book. (say it with "read")
